

Coverages with indicated dollar amounts and numbers are available as an annual limit per membership year.<sup>1</sup> Service is restricted to single dwelling entrances listed as the home address on the membership file and does not include main security doors.<sup>2</sup> See inside for more details.<sup>3</sup> Allowed once per membership year. Applicable when Member is within 160 km of their residence. Service must be provided by the preferred rental car provider. CAA Premier and Premier RV Members have up to 48 hours from the time of the tow to call CAA and request the service. The maximum allowable expense for a car rental is \$75 per day. This does not include additional charges for another driver, extra insurance, or convenience fees.<sup>4</sup> One free passport photo per membership year is allowed for Premier members only. Children (16 & under) are eligible for a free passport photo if the parent or guardian is a Premier member.

## CAA Saskatchewan Memberships

A CAA Saskatchewan membership provides 24/7 roadside assistance service and much more! CAA provides competitive insurance products, travel services, and automotive services. We also reward our members with exclusive savings, discounts, and perks with retail partners across Saskatchewan and North America.

A membership covers the Member, not the vehicle, and is not transferrable. That is, any Member who is driving, or is a passenger in, an approved vehicle will be eligible for service depending on their membership level. Memberships do not cover non-members, relatives, spouses, or friends. Membership dues are non-refundable. A 30-day grace period (buyer's remorse) may be applied.

Keep your CAA membership card on hand when requesting roadside assistance and to access all the other Member benefits outlined in this handbook.

**Primary Member:** Is the main cardholder on the CAA account. You are able to manage and maintain your membership over the phone, in-store, online, and through the CAA Mobile App.

**Associate Member:** Any individual who is 16 years old or over, living at the same residence and mailing address, can be added to the Primary Member's CAA account to receive the same coverage. Exceptions are allowed for school attendance away from home.

## Membership Levels

Depending on your membership level, access to Trip Interruption and Vehicle Return benefits may be available. Refer to this handbook for more details.

**Value:** Is for people who do not need roadside assistance but want the exclusive benefits of a CAA membership that includes savings through CAA Insurance, CAA Travel, and many other retail partners in Saskatchewan and across North America.

**Basic:** Is recommended for people who live in urban centres or commute short distances, with towing coverage up to 5km, extrication, battery boosts, battery service, tire changes, fuel delivery, and lockout service. CAA also provides coverage for bicycles and will transport you and your bike up to 5km.

**Plus & Plus RV:** Is best for people who do any highway driving and/or ride a motorcycle. Providing everything in a Basic membership plus additional towing of up to 160 km, free fuel up to 10L, and additional locksmith coverage. With Plus RV, coverage is extended to dual-wheel campers, truck campers, raised-roof vans, motorhomes, and utility/recreational trailers.

**Premier & Premier RV:** Is recommended for adventurers who like to travel long distances and want the maximum benefits from their membership. Provides everything in the Plus & RV Plus membership with an additional tow up to 320 km and an extra roadside assistance call. Also included is home lockout service, free passport photos, trip interruption assistance, complimentary two-day car rental with a tow, notary service, and a dedicated toll free number for roadside assistance service.

- ▶ If you choose not to renew your membership, call 1.800.564.6222 (Option 2) to let us know. We will ensure your account is updated and automatic renewal, if applicable, is cancelled.
- ▶ As a Member, you will have access to all our Terms and Conditions. You should familiarize yourself with our eligible vehicles to avoid any misunderstandings of vehicles you may not be eligible for services on. In any situation, you are welcome to contact us with questions, compliments, and concerns.

# MEMBERSHIP SERVICES

## Trip Interruption

Trip Interruption is an exclusive benefit for Premier Members. It can help offset certain out-of-pocket expenses should you run into trouble with getting home or to your destination.

Premier Members may be eligible for Trip Interruption in the event of a mechanical breakdown.

For reimbursement consideration, a vehicle must be disabled for 24 hours or more and the member must be more than 160 km from home. Costs incurred within 72 hours of the incident may be eligible.

Eligibility is based on the membership level at the time of incident which must be in good standing and active for at least a year.

### Eligible Expenses

- ▶ Accommodations - \$150/day
- ▶ Meals - \$50/day per Primary/Associate member
- ▶ Car rental/taxi/private transportation - \$75/day
- ▶ Commercial Transportation (bus/train/ferry/air fare) - \$600

Itemized receipts must be in the member's name and are required for all expenses being claimed. The maximum amount allowable is \$600 CAD.

## Vehicle Return

Premier (including Premier RV) Members that encounter an unexpected illness or injury that prevents them from completing their trip may be eligible for the Vehicle Return benefit which provides up to \$500 for transportation of the vehicle back to their primary residence. Proof of illness/injury must be provided by a licensed medical facility or practitioner.

Terms and Conditions: Trip Interruption and Vehicle Return benefits are only available for travel within Canada and the USA. For more details and the claim form, refer to:

# AUTOMOTIVE SERVICES

## Roadside Assistance

CAA Saskatchewan Roadside Members are allowed four (4) calls per year for Roadside Assistance, with the exception of Premier & Premier RV Members who are allowed five (5) calls.

Roadside assistance is available 24/7, without charge, from the nearest available CAA contractor. Roadside assistance service can be requested through the CAA Mobile App or by calling 1.800.222.4357 or **1.800.564.6222** (option 1).

## Membership Eligibility

Any Member who is driving or is a passenger in an approved vehicle is eligible for service. A CAA membership covers the member, not the vehicle, and is non-transferable. It will not cover service to non-members, relatives, spouses or friends, nor will it be rendered to an unattended vehicle. Members will be required to show their membership card and photo identification at the time of service. If circumstances (acceptable to CAA) prevent a Member from being present, the Member must advise CAA that a representative will present their membership card when the service provider arrives. The representative may be required to produce two additional pieces of identification. In extenuating circumstances, an exception may be made if prior arrangements have been made with CAA Saskatchewan.

## New Memberships - Conditions

A 24-hour waiting period applies to new Basic memberships for roadside assistance services. For new Plus, Premier and RV memberships, all benefits and coverages will apply except for towing, which will be restricted to 5 km during a 7-day waiting period. Additional kilometres exceeding 5 km will be at the Member's expense and a per kilometre rate will apply. After the 7-day waiting period, full towing coverage will take effect as per the membership. These conditions also apply to membership upgrades. For example, the 7-day waiting period will apply to the long tow when a Plus membership is upgraded to Premier.

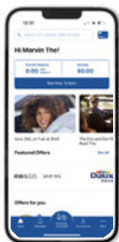
